Today, PSEA will be meeting with Management and PFT to discuss concerns and details of the three potential plans of action presented at the Board of Education meeting yesterday. We will communicate more detailed information as we know it.

Yesterday, there was a press conference with Nathan Fletcher and the San Diego Heath Department. There are 5 new cases of COVID-19 in San Diego county, but no positive cases in any San Diego County schools.
